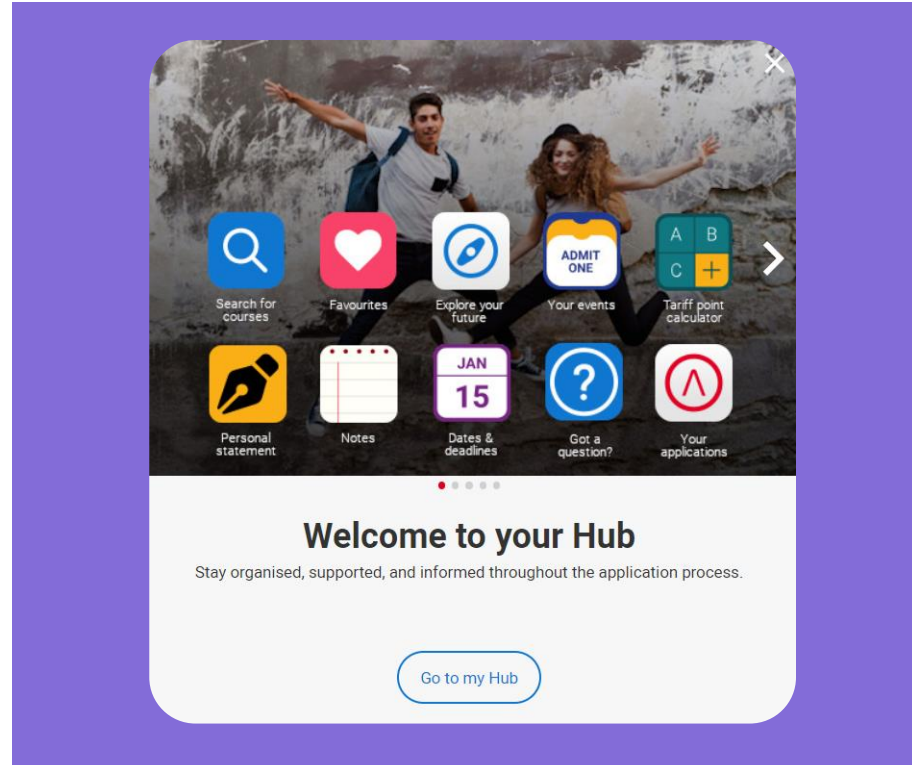

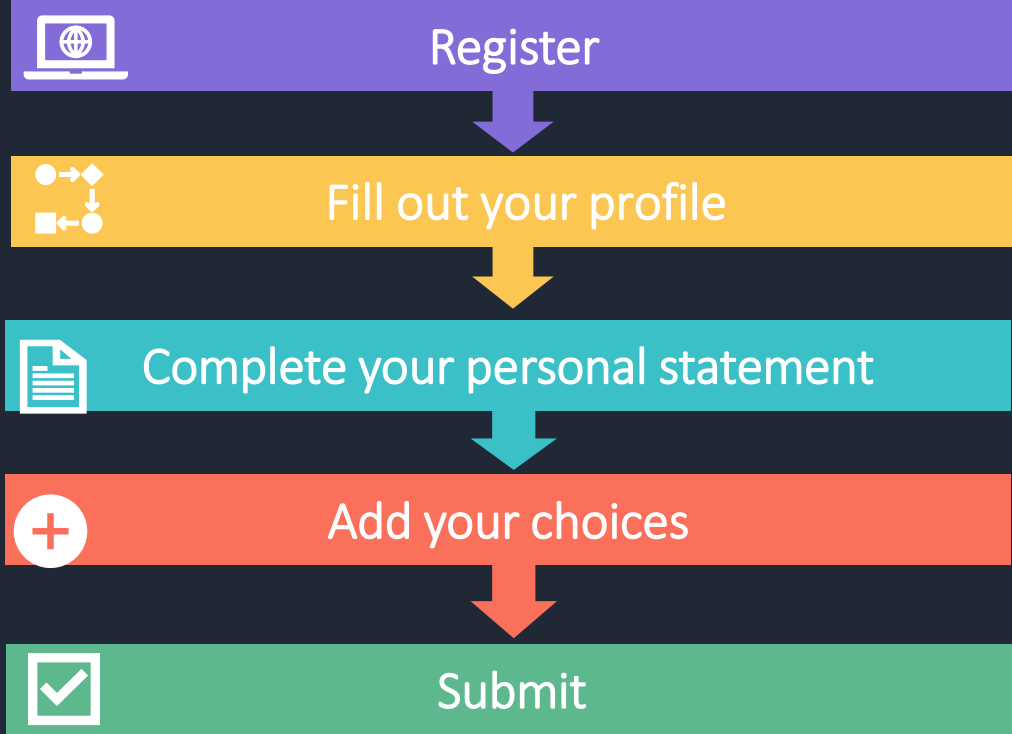


Key facts

 - Can only apply to either Oxford or Cambridge.
- Equal consideration if you apply by key dates.
- Your choices can't see where else you have applied.


After submitting your application, you need to:


